Overview of Prevention Programs

Healthy Relationships Project

Healthy Relationships Project includes Care for Kids (ages 3-5), We Care Elementary (grades 1-5), and SAFE-T (grades 6-8). The programs help kids and teens build skills for preventing violence. Each program includes information for teachers and parents, and uses ageappropriate and interactive books and activities to promote learning.

Parents In The Know

Parents and caregivers who do our a Parents in the Know program will learn skills to prevent child sexual abuse. Adults in the community will learn and practice skills for identifying grooming behavior and building accountable spaces in the community. Great for church groups and child-serving organizations.

Mandated Reporting

SARCC provides a state-approved mandated reporting training through the PA Coalition Against Rape, which satisfies all professional requirements for teachers, medical professionals, and volunteers. Trainings are offered in 1-, 2-, and 3-hour blocks.

Programs are offered both in-person and virtually. Individuals, schools, organizations, workplaces, and groups can request programs from SARCC.
